The North Shore Stars Volleyball Club is now into sixth season of developing players and leaders through volleyball. We now have over 150 young girls registered with the club between the ages of 13 and 17.

Our club was created to meet the growing demand among young girls to be active and involved in the sport of volleyball. Each year, our club continues to expand as enthusiasm for the sport swells.

The purpose of our annual Serve-a-Thon is to raise funds for transportation, accommodation and expenses at the 2012 provincial and national championships and international events. Partial proceeds from this fundraiser also donated to community programs. As an added benefit, the players have an opportunity to practice their serving when the stakes are high!

1. Players will be required to make 100 attempted serves
2. Players will pair up and each player will take turns at 25 serve intervals
3. The player's partner will count the attempts and successful serves
4. Only those serves landing in the court will be counted towards the amount of the pledge
5. Pledges will be collected within one week of the event or donations can be made at the time of the pledge
